

Checklist for a Hearing Conservation Program

1. Noise Monitoring

- Conduct regular noise level assessments.
- Identify high-noise areas and tasks.

2. Hearing Protection

- Provide appropriate hearing protection devices.
- Ensure proper fit and comfort of hearing protectors.

3. Audiometric Testing

- Offer baseline and annual hearing tests.
- Maintain records of audiometric test results.

4. Training and Education

- Educate employees about noise exposure risks.
- Train employees on the use and maintenance of hearing protectors.

5. Engineering and Administrative Controls

- Implement noise control measures.
- Rotate employees to minimize noise exposure.

6. Program Evaluation

- Regularly review and update the program.
- Conduct compliance and effectiveness audits.

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
