

Checklist for Implementing a Drug and Alcohol Testing Program

Develop a clear policy outlining the objectives, scope and prohibited substances.
Ensure legal compliance with federal and state laws, including confidentiality protections.
Define testing procedures, including types of tests and methods.
Implement random testing with a fair and unpredictable selection process.
Educate employees about the program and the dangers of substance abuse.
Train supervisors to recognize signs of abuse and handle testing procedures.
Provide Employee Assistance Programs for support and rehabilitation.
Regularly review and update the program to maintain its effectiveness.
Collect employee feedback to continuously improve the program.

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
